STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT in Relation to Employees and Office Expenses of the Department of the Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The attorney general is authorized to employ in his office 2 in addition to the officers named in section sixty-seven of 3 chapter eighty-two, revised statutes, as amended by chap- 4 ter two hundred and ten, of the public laws of nineteen 5 hundred and nineteen, additional clerks as the business of 6 his office may demand, whose appointment and compensa- 7 tion shall be subject to the approval of the governor and 8 council. He may also incur a reasonable expense for post- 9 age, printing, stationery, and other office expenses.
