IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-two, Chapter One Hundred Seventeen, Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapters Thirty-nine, and One Hundred Sixty-seven, Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Chapter Two Hundred Fourteen, Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen and Chapter Two Hundred Nineteen, Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to Salary of County Commissioners, of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-two of chapter one hundred seventeen of the  
2 revised statutes, as amended by chapters thirty-nine and one  
3 hundred sixty-seven of the public laws of nineteen hundred  
4 and seventeen, chapter two hundred fourteen of the public

5 laws of nineteen hundred nineteen and by chapter two  
6 hundred nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred  
7 twenty-one, is hereby further amended by striking out the  
8 words “seven hundred fifty” in the fourth line, and insert-  
9 ing in place thereof the words ‘one thousand’ so that said  
10 section as amended shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 42. The county commissioners in the several coun-  
2 ties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the  
3 counties in monthly payments paid on the last day of each  
4 month, as follows:

‘Androscoggin, one thousand dollars.

‘Aroostook, eleven hundred dollars.

‘Cumberland, fifteen hundred dollars.

‘Franklin, four hundred fifty dollars.

‘Hancock, seven hundred fifty dollars.

‘Kennebec, one thousand dollars.

‘Knox, four hundred dollars.

‘Lincoln, three hundred dollars.

‘Oxford, six hundred dollars.

‘Penobscot, twelve hundred dollars.

‘Piscataquis, five hundred dollars.

‘Sagadahoc, four hundred dollars.

‘Somerset, six hundred fifty dollars.

‘Waldo, four hundred dollars.

‘Washington, six hundred fifty dollars.

‘York, eight hundred fifty dollars.

‘Said salaries shall be in full for all services, expenses and

2 travel, including the management of the jails and work-  
3 shops and the sale of their products, except actual necessary  
4 cash expenses incurred outside of their respective counties  
5 for the transaction of official business; all bills for such  
6 expenses shall be approved by the clerk of courts and the  
7 county attorney of their county; excepting also, such ex-  
8 penses as are provided for in section twenty-six of chapter  
9 eighty-three.'
