STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Amending Chapter Two Hundred Twenty-two of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen, relating to Fees of Constables.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Chapter two hundred twenty-two of the public laws of 2 nineteen hundred and nineteen is hereby amended by add-3 ing to said chapter the following paragraph:

'For any of the above enumerated services in civil cases 2 which a constable may legally perform he shall receive the 3 same fees as are provided above for deputy sheriffs.'
