STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Improvements on Nash Stream and the East and West Branches Thereof in Coplin Plantation, and in the Township of Redington in the County of Franklin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Albion L. Savage of Stratton in the County of

Franklin and State of Maine, his associates, successors and

assigns are hereby authorized and empowered to locate,

erect and maintain in Nash stream and the East and West

branches thereof, on land owned by Hollingsworth &

Whitney Company and others in Coplin Plantation, and

land owned by Chandler and Hovey or others in the town
ship of Redington in the County of Franklin and State of

9 Maine, anywhere on said Nash stream, or the East and 10 West branches thereof, between and including the dam on II the East branch of said Nash stream and located on or near 12 the South line of said Coplin Plantation, and including the 13 dam on the West branch of said Nash stream, and located 14 about one-fourth of a mile south of the South line of said 15 Coplin Plantation, and the North line of said Coplin Planta-16 tion, such dams as may be necessary, including the two 17 dams above mentioned and already erected and maintained 18 by him, to raise a head of water to facilitate the driving of 19 logs, pulpwood and other lumber, down said Nash stream 20 and the East and West branches thereof; and to build side 21 dams, piers and rack booms, remove rocks, and make other 22 improvements on said Nash stream and the East and West 23 branches thereof, and their tributaries, within the limits of 24 said Coplin Plantation, and in the township of Redington 25 only to the dams above mentioned and already built, for the 26 purpose of facilitating the driving of logs, pulpwood and 27 other lumber down the same.

Sect. 2. Said Albion L. Savage, his associates, successors 2 and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to take 3 lands and materials necessary to build and maintain such 4 dams and booms and make such improvements, and may 5 flow contiguous lands so far as necessary to raise suitable 6 heads of water, to attach his booms and piers to land ad-7 jacent to said Nash stream and the East and West branches 8 thereof, and may with his agents, servants and teams pass

9 and repass over and along the shores of said Nash stream 10 and the East and West branches thereof, and to and from 11 the same, over the land of other persons, for the purpose 12 aforesaid, and for managing said dams, piers and booms, 13 making compensation therefor as is provided in case of 14 damage for lands taken in laying out highways.

Sect. 3. The said Albion L. Savage, his associates, suc-2 cessors and assigns, may demand and receive toll for the 3 passage of logs, pulpwood and other lumber over either of 4 his said dams, and on all logs, pulpwood and other lumber 5 landed in said Nash stream on the East and West branches 6 thereof, above the North line of said Coplin Plantation, of 7 sixty cents per thousand feet for logs and other lumber, and 8 thirty cents per cord for pulpwood, at the same scale adopted 9 by the Dead River Log Driving Company, and the said 10 Albion L. Savage, his associates, successors and assigns, II shall have a lien on all logs, pulpwood and other lumber 12 that may pass over his said dams and improvements, for the 13 payment of said toll, and unless said toll is paid within 14 thirty days after said logs, pulpwood or other lumber shall 15 have passed by the North line of said Coplin Plantation, said 16 Albion L. Savage, his associates, successors and assigns, 17 shall have a lien on said logs, pulpwood or other lumber 18 to be enforced in the same manner as liens for driving of 19 logs or lumber under the provisions of section forty-nine 20 of chapter ninety-six of the revised statutes and acts amend-21 atory thereof and additional thereto. No tolls shall be

22 levied on lumber cut from land now owned by the Stratton 23 Manufacturing Company.

Sect. 4. When the said Albion L. Savage, his associates, 2 successors and assigns, have received from tolls, his outlay 3 on dams, improvements and repairs made up to that time, 4 and six per cent interest thereon, then the toll shall be 5 reduced to a sum sufficient to keep the works in repair. 6 The treasurer of the Kennebec Log Driving Company for 7 the time being is appointed to audit the accounts and deter-8 mine the cost of said dams and improvements, and repairs. Sect. 5. The cost of dams and improvements already 2 erected upon said Nash stream and the East and West 3 branches thereof, by the said Albion L. Savage since Janu-4 ary first, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, shall 5 be included in the cost of the dams and improvements 6 designated in this act.
