STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the State School for Boys for Maintenance and Other Purposes.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 maintenance of the state school for boys, the following 3 sums:

For personal services, namely, salaries and wages of all officers and employees, except those wholly engaged in repairs and construction of buildings and equipment:

For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, the sum of twenty thousand dollars.
