RESOLVE, in Favor of the State School for Boys for Main-  
tenance and Other Purposes.

---

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for  
2 maintenance of the state school for boys, the following  
3 sums:

For personal services, namely, salaries and wages  
of all officers and employees, except those  
wholly engaged in repairs and construction of  
buildings and equipment:

For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nine-  
teen hundred and twenty-four, the sum of  
twenty thousand dollars.

\$20,000.00

For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, the sum of twenty thousand dollars.	20,000.00
For maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs, replacements, equipment, and for general expenses :	
For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, the sum of forty-seven thousand dollars.	47,000.00
For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, the sum of forty-seven thousand dollars.	47,000.00
For rebuilding the piggery which was destroyed by fire, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars.	1,500.00
This sum to be additional to the amount received for insurance on said destroyed piggery and to be available for expenditure during the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-four.	
For interest on the Isaac Sanford legacy :	
For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, the sum of forty-two dollars.	42.00
For the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, the sum of forty-two dollars.	42.00
Making a total of one hundred and thirty-five thousand five hundred and eighty-four dollars.	<hr/> \$135,584.00

## STATEMENT

The appropriations specified in the foregoing resolve are necessary for the proper and efficient operation of the state school for boys during the two fiscal years for which the appropriations are to be made, and the aggregate of the appropriations, except as applies to rebuilding the piggery, the necessity for which arose after the estimates were made up, is in accordance with the recommendations of the committee on budget.
