IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to the Duties of the Superintendent of
Public Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

In addition to the duties now imposed upon the superintendent of public buildings by section twenty-two of chapter two of the revised statutes, he shall take charge of the adjutant general's office buildings, the Blaine mansion and its grounds, the Blaine memorial, the state park, and all other property of the state within the limits of the city of Augusta, except the Augusta state hospital, the garage connected with the highway department and the property of the military department.

The governor and council shall have authority to fix his
2 compensation for the additional duties herewith imposed.
