RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Repair of the Historic Block House at the Junction of the St. John River and the Fish River at Fort Kent.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of two hundred dollars or so much thereof as may be
3 necessary, for the repair of the block house at the junction
4 of the St. John river and the Fish river at Fort Kent, said
5 sum to be expended under the direction of the governor
6 and council.
