#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT for Expediting Highway and Bridge Construction Work under Legislative Appropriations.

EMERGENCY PREAMBLE. Whereas, the season for road work in the state of Maine begins about April 15; and

Whereas, appropriations made by the legislature for road work are not available until the beginning of the fiscal year, on July 1; and

Whereas, between April 15 and July 1 road work can be done more advantageously, economically and with less inconvenience to the travelling public than at any other time; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section sixteen of

article thirty-one of the constitution of the state of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Any town to which under any legislative en2 actment or resolve money will become available for road
3 and bridge work at the beginning of the fiscal year, may,
4 on or at any time after April fifteenth preceding the com5 mencement of the fiscal year for which such appropriation
6 is made, anticipate the expenditure of any appropriation
7 for repair or improvement of a highway or bridge, by
8 arranging to finance such work from funds of the town,
9 or otherwise, prior to the date when such appropriation
10 will become available.

- Sect. 2. The state auditor is hereby authorized to approve 2 any bill or account created in accordance with the pro-3 visions of section one of this act, against any appropriation 4 available in any fiscal year, as though said bill or account 5 was incurred during the time for which said appropriation 6 was made.
- Sect. 3. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, 2 this act shall take effect when approved.
