STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Attorney General to Procure Pictures of Former Attorneys General and Appropriating Money Therefor.

Resolved: That the attorney general is hereby authorized 2 to procure for the attorney general's office in the state house 3 suitable framed pictures of the former attorneys general 4 of Maine at an expense not to exceed two hundred dollars, 5 which sum or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 6 hereby appropriated for that purpose from any money in 7 the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Many of the important departments of the state have suitable pictures of former heads of such departments, and of the thirty-two former attorneys general of Maine, there is a picture of only one suitable for framing in the office. For the small sum called for, a complete set of pictures with frames can be obtained at this time, with the exception of three.
