STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred Seventeen, Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen, Relating to Appropriation for Normal Schools and Madawaska Training School.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

An act to amend chapter two hundred seventeen by striking out after "of" in line six "sixty thousand" and inserting therefor the words 'seventy thousand,' and striking out all of the section following the word "equipment in line nine and substituting therefor 'The amount provided for in this chapter shall be deducted from the state school fund,' so that the section amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. In order to provide for the need of more and
2 better trained teachers for the schools of the state, the board
3 of trustees of the state normal schools is hereby authorized
4 to provide for upkeep, equipment and extensions of the sev-
5 eral normal schools and the Madawaska Training School,
6 for which purpose there shall be appropriated the sum of
7 seventy thousand dollars beginning with the year nineteen
8 hundred and twenty-one, and the same amount annually
9 thereafter, to be expended under the direction of the board
10 of state normal school trustees for extensions in buildings,
11 repairs and equipment. The amount provided for in this
12 chapter shall be deducted from the state school fund.'
