STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Three Thousand Dollars for the Purpose of Investigating the Tax Exemption Laws of the State of Maine as Found in Section Six, Chapter 10, of the Revised Statutes.

Resolved: That the sum of one thousand five hundred 2 dollars is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year of nine-3 teen hundred and twenty-four and the sum of one thousand 4 five hundred dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred 5 and twenty-five to pay the necessary expenses of a board 6 of five members consisting of the state auditor, chairman 7 board of state assessors, ex-officio and three citizens of the 8 state to be appointed by the governor, the duties of said

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9 board being to investigate the tax exemption laws of the 10 state and to collect and tabulate statistics showing the 11 amount of tax exempt property in the several classes as 12 enumerated in chapter ten, section six, of the revised stat-13 utes, and amendments thereto. Said board shall report its 14 findings together with its recommendations to the governor 15 on or before December first, nineteen hundred and twenty-16 four.

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
