STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide for Investigation and Survey of Bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The state highway commission is hereby authorized and 2 directed to make a complete investigation and survey of all 3 bridges on public highways in the state, securing such in-4 formation as it may deem necessary, for the purpose of 5 establishing a future policy for bridge maintenance, con-6 struction and reconstruction.

This work is to be completed before December first, nine-2 teen hundred and twenty-four, and all information obtained 3 shall be tabulated, printed and available for the use of the 4 eighty-second legislature.

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The commission is authorized to employ such additional aid 2 as it may deem necessary to effectively carry out the work 3 prescribed by this resolve, and all salaries and expenses shall 4 be paid from the fund provided for maintenance and ad-5 ministration. The total cost of the work shall not exceed 6 twelve thousand dollars.
