STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT In Relation to the Fees to be Charged by the Board of Registration of Medicine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eleven, of chapter eighteen, of the revised stat-

- 2 utes, is hereby amended by striking out in the third and
- 3 twelfth lines of said sections the word "fifteen," and in-
- 4 serting in place thereof the word 'twenty-five'; so that as
- 5 amended said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 11. Any person shall, upon the payment of a fee

- 2 of twenty-five dollars be entitled to examination, and if
- 3 found qualified by a majority of the members of the board
- 4 present shall be registered as a physician or surgeon, and
- 5 shall receive a certificate thereof under the seal of the

6 board, and signed by the chairman and secretary, which 7 shall state the facts and must be publicly displayed at the 8 person's principal place of business as long as said person 9 continues such practice for gain or hire. Any person re-10 fused registration may be re-examined at the regular meet-11 ing of said board, within two years of the time of such re-12 fusal, without additional fee and thereafter may be 13 examined as often as he may desire upon payment of the 14 fee of twenty-five dollars for each examination. All fees 15 received by the board hereunder shall be paid by the secre-16 tary thereof into the treasury of the state once in each 17 month.
