HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE BILL

NUMBER 285

Senate Bill No. 285 is hereby amended by striking out  
2 after the word "forfeited" in the fourth line of the second  
3 section thereof, the words "unless the possession or control  
4 of the person using the same for the unlawful transpor-  
5 tation aforesaid shall be without the knowledge of the  
6 person or corporation claiming such right, interest or title"  
7 and inserting in place thereof the words, 'unless the use  
8 of the same for the transportation of intoxicating liquors  
9 as aforesaid was without his knowledge or consent' and  
10 said section two of said bill is further amended by striking  
11 out after the word "and" in the second line of the third

12 paragraph of said section the words, "prove that the posses-  
13 sion and control of the same was without his knowledge  
14 or consent or the knowledge or consent of any person hold-  
15 ing title under or by virtue of a contract with him" and  
16 inserting in place thereof the words, 'prove that the use of  
17 the same for the transportation of intoxicating liquors as  
18 aforesaid was without his knowledge or consent and the  
19 court may determine in the proceeding on said claim the  
20 right, interest or title, if any, of said claimant.'
