STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Regulate the Right of Way of Vehicles at Intersecting Public Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

All vehicles shall have the right of way over other vehicles
2 approaching at intersecting public ways from the left, and
3 shall give the right of way to those approaching from the
4 right; except that traffic officers stationed at such inter-
5 sections may otherwise regulate traffic thereat.
