## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Five of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter One Hundred and Seventy of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, as Amended by chapter Eighty-Seven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to the Salaries of Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Revised Statutes, c. 117, Sec. 5; 1917, c. 170; 1921, c. 87;

- 3 Supreme Judicial Court, Amended. Section five of chapter
- 4 one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amend-

6 of nineteen hundred and seventy of the Public Laws
6 of nineteen hundred and seventeen, as amended by chapter
7 eighty-seven of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and
8 twenty-one, is hereby amended by striking out the words
9 "six thousand" in the second line thereof, and inserting in
10 place thereof the words 'seven thousand five hundred' so
11 that said section five as amended by chapter one hundred
12 and seventy of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
13 seventeen, as amended by chapter eighty-seven of the Public
14 Laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one and as amended
15 by this amendment, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. Salaries Increased to \$7500. The justices of the 2 supreme judicial court shall each receive an annual salary 3 of seven thousand five hundred dollars. Each justice shall 4 be reimbursed by the state for his expenses actually and 5 reasonably incurred in attending meetings appointed by the 6 chief justice under the provisions of section forty-three, of 7 chapter eighty-two, and the sessions of the law court, upon 8 presentation to the state auditor of a detailed statement of g such expenses. When any justice of said court holds nisi 10 prius terms of said court in any county other than the II county in which he resides, or when any hearing of a cause 12 in law or in equity is had in vacation before a justice of 13 said court other than one residing in the county where said 14 hearing is held, such justice shall be reimbursed by the 15 state for his expenses actually and reasonably incurred in 16 holding such terms, or in attending said hearing, upon

17 presentation to the state auditor of a detailed statement of 18 such expenses. The counties wherein such justices reside, 19 have their offices, or are holding court, shall also receive 20 from the state the expenses necessarily incurred by such 21 justices for postage, stationery, express and telephone tolls.'
