IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred Twenty of Chapter Sixteen, Relating to the Appointment of the State Superintendent of Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred twenty, chapter sixteen of the revised

2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the second

3 and third lines thereof the words "superintendent of public

4 schools" and inserting therefor the words 'commissioner of

5 education,' and adding at the close of the section the words

6 'wherever the title "state superintendent of public schools"

7 is used it shall mean the "state commissioner of education,"

8 so that the section as amended shall read:

'Sect. 120. The governor with the advice and consent 2 of the council shall appoint a state commissioner of edu-3 cation, who shall continue in office three years, or during 4 the pleasure of the executive. Vacancies shall be filled by 5 a new appointment for a like term.'
