AN ACT Empowering the Governor and Council to Make  
Temporary Appointment of United States Senator to Fill  
Vacancy.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

When a vacancy occurs in the office of United States  
2 senator from this state, the governor, with the advice and  
3 consent of the council, is hereby empowered to make tem-  
4 porary appointment until the people fill the vacancy by  
5 election at the next regular state election for state officers.
