IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Empowering the Governor and Council to Make Temporary Appointment of United States Senator to Fill Vacancy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

When a vacancy occurs in the office of United States

- 2 senator from this state, the governor, with the advice and
- 3 consent of the council, is hereby empowered to make tem-
- 4 porary appointment until the people fill the vacancy by
- 5 election at the next regular state election for state officers.
