STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Reunite the towns of Owl's Head and South
Thomaston.

Whereas, the annual town meeting of South Thomaston occurs in March and newly elected assessors assume their duties and whereas the beginning of the fiscal year for South Thomaston and Owl's Head is March 1st, and that ninety days after passage of this act would create a confusion, and whereas these facts render the passage of this act immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and constitute an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of the state of Maine, now therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That the town of Owl's Head as constituted
2 and created by chapter one hundred and forty-seven of the
3 private and special laws of the state of Maine as passed by
4 the eightieth legislature, 1921, now revert to, become a part
5 of and be annexed to the town of South Thomaston, as
6 formerly.

Sect. 2. That chapter one hundred and forty-seven of the
2 private and special laws of the state of Maine as passed by
3 the eightieth legislature, 1921, be and hereby is repealed.

Sect. 3. That all legally authorized existing debts and
2 obligations of the town of Owl's Head be assumed by the
3 town of South Thomaston.

Sect. 4. That all monies and indebtedness of whatsoever
2 nature due the town of Owl's Head, by virtue of this act
3 shall be due the town of South Thomaston, and said South
4 Thomaston shall have legal right to collect the same.

Sect. 5. The several inhabitants of the town of Owl's
2 Head shall immediately upon the coming of this act into
3 effect become citizens of the town of South Thomaston
4 with full powers, rights and privileges as citizens of South
5 Thomaston, and be subject to all the duties and obligations
6 of citizens of South Thomaston.

Sect. 6. In view of the emergency recited in the preamble
2 this act shall take effect when approved.
