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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-nine of Chapter Sixty-seven of the Revised Statutes Relating to Fees to be Paid by Executor or Administrator.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-nine of chapter sixty-seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifty cents" after the word "receive" in the second line thereof, and after the word "deeds" in the third line thereof and inserting instead thereof the words 'one dollar,' so that said section thirty-nine as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 39. Fees to be paid by executor or administrator. 2 R. S. c. 65, sec. 22. For making and certifying to the

3 register of deeds copies of devises of real estate, the register  
4 of probate shall receive one dollar for each copy so certified,  
5 and the register of deeds one dollar for entering and record-  
6 ing the same, said sums to be paid by the executor or  
7 administrator when said will is proved, to the register of  
8 probate, who shall pay fifty cents to the register of deeds  
9 at the time said certified copy is furnished to him; and the  
10 executor or administrator shall charge said sums in his  
11 account.'
