STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Persons Convicted of Violating the
Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person, having a criminal record for any offense, shall
2 be placed on probation by any court, after having been found
3 guilty of any violation of the motor vehicle laws of this
4 state, nor shall any court suspend sentence or order the case
5 to be nol prossed or placed on file.
