STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-two, Chapter One Hundred Seventeen, Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter One Hundred Eighty-three, Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen, and by Chapter One Hundred Fifty-two, Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relating to the Board of State Assessors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-two of chapter one hundred seventeen of
2 the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred
3 eighty-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred seven-
4 teen and by chapter one hundred fifty-two of the public
5 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby further

6 amended by striking out the words "for the chairman twen-
7 ty-five hundred dollars, and for each member two thou-
8 sand dollars," in the second and third lines, and inserting
9 in place thereof the words 'twenty-five hundred dollars,'
10 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 32. The annual salary of each member of the state
2 board of assessors shall be twenty-five hundred dollars.
3 They shall also receive their actual expenses incurred in
4 the performance of their official duties. They shall employ
5 a chief clerk and such other clerical assistance as may be
6 necessary. The chief clerk in the office of the board of
7 state assessors shall receive an annual salary of twenty-
8 five hundred dollars and he shall also receive his actual
9 expenses incurred in the performance of his official duties.'
