STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Sale of Proprietary Medicines, Drugs, Extracts, and Other Combinations for Beverage or Tippling Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever knowingly sells to any person for beverage or 2 tippling purposes any patent or proprietary medicine, ton-3 sorial or medicinal preparation, flavoring extract or syrup, 4 or any other combination containing one-half of one per 5 cent or more of alcohol by volume shall be deemed a com-6 mon seller, and upon conviction shall be punished accord-

7 ingly.
