STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Forty of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, Relative to Compensation of Clerks of Courts, of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., chapter 117, sec. 40; relating to compensation of

- 2 clerks of courts, amended. Section forty of chapter one
- 3 hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes is hereby
- 4 amended by striking out the words "Cumberland, twenty-
- 5 five hundred dollars, deputy clerk of courts, eighteen hun-
- 6 dred dollars," and substituting in place thereof the words
- 7 'Cumberland, twenty-eight hundred dollars, deputy clerk of

8 courts, twenty hundred dollars,' so that said section as 9 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 40. The clerks of the judicial courts in the several 2 counties shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries 3 of the counties in monthly payments paid on the last day 4 of each month, as follows:

Androscoggin, twenty-two hundred dollars,
Aroostook, two thousand dollars,
Cumberland, twenty-eight hundred dollars, deputy clerk of
2 courts, twenty hundred dollars,

Franklin, fourteen hundred dollars,
Hancock, twenty-one hundred dollars,
Kennebec, twenty-five hundred dollars,
Knox, fifteen hundred dollars,
Lincoln, twelve hundred dollars,
Oxford, eighteen hundred dollars,
Penobscot, twenty-five hundred dollars,
Piscataquis, fourteen hundred dollars,
Sagadahoc, two thousand dollars,
Somerset, twenty-five hundred dollars,
Waldo, twelve hundred dollars,
Washington, fourteen hundred and fifty dollars,
York, twenty-five hundred dollars.

The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation 2 for the performance of all duties required of clerks, in-3 cluding those performed by them as clerks of the supreme 4 judicial court, superior and county commissioners' courts,

5 or by clerks pro tempore employed by them, and the sum 6 provided for the clerk of Lincoln county shall be in full 7 for all such services and also in full for services as clerk 8 of the Lincoln municipal court, except as provided in secgetion forty-five of chapter eighty-two of the revised station utes. They shall account quarterly under oath to the country treasurer for all fees received by them or payable to 12 them by virtue of the office, except fees collected by them 13 in naturalization proceedings under the act of congress of 14 June twenty-ninth, nineteen hundred and six, as amended 15 by the act of congress on June twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and ten, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole 17 amount of the same to the treasurers of their respective 18 counties quarterly on the first days of January, April, July 19 and October of each year.'
