STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine State Prison for Main-
tenance and Current Expenses.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for
2 the Maine state prison for the fiscal year July first, nine-
3 teen hundred twenty-three, to June thirtieth, nineteen hun-
4 dred twenty-four, inclusive, the sum of seventy-three thou-
5 sand eight hundred dollars for the purposes hereinafter
6 specified, namely:

July 1, 1923—June 30, 1924

Personal services of officers and employees, fifty

thousand dollars \$50,000.00

Maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs on buildings and general expenses, twenty thousand dollars \$20,000.00

Retiring and pensioning prison officials, three thousand eight hundred dollars \$3,800.00

And be it further resolved that there be, and hereby is
 2 appropriated for the Maine state prison for the fiscal year
 3 July first, nineteen hundred twenty-four, to June thirtieth,
 4 nineteen hundred twenty-five, inclusive, the further sum
 5 of seventy-three thousand eight hundred dollars for the
 6 same purpose hereinbefore specified, divided as follows,
 7 namely:

Personal services of officers and employees, fifty thousand dollars \$50,000.00

Maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, repairs on buildings and general expenses, twenty thousand dollars \$20,000.00

Retiring and pensioning prison officials, three thousand eight hundred dollars..... \$3,000.00

Provided that any balances of the foregoing appropriations which remain unexpended at the end of the first fiscal
 2 period herein specified shall be available for expenditure
 3 during the second fiscal period.
