AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred and Seventy-two, S. L., 1899 and Amended by Chapter Two Hundred and Fifty-nine S. L. of 1903, Relating to a Close Time on Lobster Traps in the Waters of Pigeon Hill bay by striking Out All of Said Section and Inserting in Place Thereof the Following:

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

‘No person shall set any trap or other device used for
2 catching lobsters between July 1st and 9 a. m., August 31st
3 of each year under a penalty of ten dollars for each trap or
4 other device set within the following described limits: in
5 the waters of Pigeon Hill bay so-called.’
