IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred and Eleven of the Public Laws of 1921, Relating to Court Jurisdiction of Violation of the Motor Vehicle Law and Transmission of Fines to the Highway Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Acts of 1921, chapter two hundred and eleven, section 2 ninety-three, relating to fines, amended. Section ninety-3 three of chapter two hundred and eleven of the public laws 4 of nineteen hundred and twenty-one is hereby amended by 5 adding after the words "under this act" in the fifth line 6 thereof the words 'on complaints made by the state high-

7 way commission or any of its inspectors,' so that said sec-
8 tion as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 93. Court jurisdiction of violations; fines to be
2 transmitted to commission. Municipal and police courts
3 and trial justices in their respective counties shall have con-
4 current jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and superior
5 courts over all prosecutions for all violations of the provi-
6 sions of this act. All fines imposed and collected under
7 this act on complaints made by the state highway commis-
8 sion or any of its inspectors shall be transmitted to the
9 commissions and applied as provided in section ninety-two.'
