STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred and Thirty-two of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred and Three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one Entitled, "An Act to Create the Maine Water Power Commission."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and thirty-two two of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen as amended by section one of chapter two hundred and three of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. All duties, powers, and privileges heretofore con-

2 ferred and imposed by any statute upon the Maine water
3 power commission are hereby conferred and imposed upon
4 the public utilities commission, and all books, plans, papers,
5 records, and other property of the state now in possession
6 of the Maine water power commission and its employees,
7 shall be turned over to the public utilities commission by the
8 officers of the Maine water power commission.

Sect. 3. Tenure of office of all officers, employees and
2 servants of the Maine water power commission, is hereby
3 terminated.
