STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Operation of Motor Vehicles by Persons Whose Licenses Have Been Revoked in This State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever obtains a license in a foreign state or country 2 to operate a motor vehicle, his license in this state having 3 been revoked and not restored to him, and thereafter by 4 virtue of his foreign license operates any motor vehicle 5 upon any highway within this state, shall be guilty of a 6 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before any trial 7 justice or court within the state, shall be fined not less than 8 one hundred dollars and shall serve thirty days in jail.
