AN ACT to Provide for the Recording of Leases and Assign-
ments or Discharges of Mortgages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Leases and discharges or assignments of mortgages must
2 have a certificate of acknowledgment, or proof of execu-
3 tion endorsed on, or annexed to same, as provided relative
4 to the acknowledgment or proof of execution of deeds, be-
5 fore recording said documents in the registry of deeds.
