STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Eastern Maine Railroad.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. CHARTER OF EASTERN MAINE RAIL-
2 ROAD EXTENDED. The rights, powers and privileges of
3 the Eastern Maine railroad which were granted by chapter
4 one hundred and eighty-eight of the private and special
5 laws of nineteen hundred and eleven and have subsequently
6 been amended and extended by successive legislatures to
7 date, are hereby extended two years additional, and the
8 persons named in said act and their associates and suc-
9 cessors shall have the rights, powers and privileges that
10 were granted to them by said act and amendments thereof

11 to be exercised by them for the same purposes as specified
12 in said act and the amendments thereof.

Sect. 2. EXISTING STATUTES NOT AFFECTED.

2 Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal or shall be
3 construed as repealing the whole or any part of any exist-
4 ing statute. And all the rights and duties herein mentioned
5 shall be exercised and performed in accordance with all the
6 applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of the revised
7 statutes, and acts amendatory thereof or additional thereto.
