STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Create a Board of Road Commissioners in the
Town of Mt. Desert.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Mount Desert in the county of
2 Hancock, at any annual town meeting may elect, in the
3 manner prescribed for the election of town officers in
4 chapter one hundred and ninety-one of the private and
5 special laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, a board
6 of three road commissioners, one for a term of one year,
7 one for a term of two years, and one for a term of three
8 years, and thereafter shall elect one each year for a three
9 years' term.

Said board shall serve instead of the road commissioner
2 or commissioners, provided for by general statute, and have
3 the same powers in relation to the construction and repair
4 of roads, bridges and sidewalks as the road commissioners
5 and the municipal officers have under such general statute,
6 and be subject to the same duties in relation thereto.

The compensation of such commissioners shall not exceed
2 fifty dollars each, per year. They shall employ a super-
3 intendent or superintendents of roads, not one of their own
4 number. Such superintendent shall be under the control
5 of said board of commissioners, and be subject to dis-
6 charge by them.

Sect. 2. This act shall not become operative until it is
2 ratified by said town of Mount Desert at an annual town
3 meeting or a special town meeting called by a warrant
4 containing an article for the purpose.

At any annual meeting ratifying this act the board thus
2 provided for may be elected.
