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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-five of Chapter One Hun-  
dred Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Clerk  
Hire in the Office of Clerk of Courts in Androscoggin  
County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred seventeen of the  
2 revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred nine-  
3 teen of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, by  
4 striking out the last five words, "seven hundred and eighty  
5 dollars," in the second paragraph of said section, relating  
6 to Androscoggin county, and inserting in lieu thereof the

7 words 'one thousand and forty dollars,' so that the section  
8 as amended shall read:

'Androscoggin county: for clerks in the office of register  
2 of deeds, fifteen hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of  
3 register of probate, one thousand and forty dollars; for  
4 clerks in the office of clerk of courts, one thousand and  
5 forty dollars.'
