STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Expenditure of the Department of Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All expenditures of the Department of Public

- 2 Schools, including salaries and general office expenses,
- 3 shall be taken from the state school fund.
 - Sect. 2. Before distribution to the cities and towns, there
- 2 shall be deducted from the state school fund all sums ap-
- 3 propriated by existing laws for specific purposes, together
- 4 with all sums appropriated by the eighty-first legislature
- 5 for specific purposes.
- Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
