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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

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**AN ACT** Relating to the Expenditure of the Department of  
Public Schools.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All expenditures of the Department of Public  
2 Schools, including salaries and general office expenses,  
3 shall be taken from the state school fund.

Sect. 2. Before distribution to the cities and towns, there  
2 shall be deducted from the state school fund all sums ap-  
3 propriated by existing laws for specific purposes, together  
4 with all sums appropriated by the eighty-first legislature  
5 for specific purposes.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this  
2 act are hereby repealed.
