AN ACT Relating to Deposits in Savings Banks.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-five of chapter fifty-two of the revised  
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of said  
3 section, and enacting in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 25. Deposits in the names of two persons. 1907 c.  
2 119 1915 c. 96. When a deposit has been made or shall  
3 hereafter be made in any bank, institution for savings,  
4 trust company, or loan and building association transacting  
5 business in this state, in the names of two persons, payable  
6 to either, such deposit or any part thereof, or the interests

7 and dividends thereon, may be paid to either of said per-  
8 sons, while both are living.'
