STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph nine, section one, chapter seventy-six of the
2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out after
3 the word "administrator" the words "after three years from
4 the granting of administration," so that said paragraph, as
5 amended, shall read as follows:

'IX. Of public administrators, to sell any or all of the
2 real estate of the deceased, when it appears to be for the
3 interest of all concerned, and that no heir or other person
4 interested therein, except creditors, can be found in the
5 United States.'
