**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

AN ACT Relating to Payment of Legacies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-six, chapter seventy of the revised statutes
2 as amended by chapter forty of the public laws of nineteen
3 hundred and nineteen, is hereby amended by striking out
4 the following words in the last two lines: "unless he has
5 failed to give notice of his appointment as required by law
6 and the judge of probate," so that said section, as amended,
7 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 26. Legacies, when payable. 1919, c. 40. Legacies
2 shall be payable in twenty months after final allowance of
3 the will; but such payments shall not be affected by any

4 claims presented to the executor, or administrator with
5 the will annexed, or filed in the probate office after the
6 expiration of said twenty months and after such payment;
7 nor shall the executor or administrator with the will an-
8 nexed be responsible for the payments of said legacies on
9 account of such claims.'
