STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Sessions of Probate Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter sixty-seven of the revised statutes
2 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place there-
3 of:

'Sect. 5. Probate court always in session. Probate court
2 shall always be open in each county for all matters over
3 which it has jurisdiction, except upon days on which, by
4 law, no court is held, but it shall have certain fixed days
5 and places to be made known by public notification thereof
6 in their respective counties, to which all matters requiring
7 public notice shall be made returnable; and in case of the

8 absence of the judge or vacancy in the office at the time of
9 holding any court, the register or acting register may ad-
10 journ the same until the judge can attend or some other
11 probate judge can be notified and attend.'
