STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Registers of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty of chapter sixty-seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said section, and enacting in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 40. Fees of Registers. R. S. c. 65, sec. 36. The register shall receive for such copies as are taxable by law twelve cents a page, for authenticating the official signature of a magistrate, twenty-five cents; for each certificate under seal of the court, of the appointment and qualification of an administrator, executor, guardian, trustee or conservator, fifty cents; but he shall have only his actual expenses for

9 place where the probate court is held, papers necessary for
10 the settlement of any estate or account in said court.'
