STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws and of the Commissioners from Maine for the Promotion of Uniformity of Legislation in the United States.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred dollars for the 2 period from July 1, 1923 to July 1, 1924, and the sum of 3 five hundred dollars for the period from July 1, 1924 to 4 July 1, 1925, be and hereby is appropriated, of which two 5 hundred dollars for the year beginning July 1, 1923, and 6 two hundred dollars for the year beginning July 1, 1924, 7 shall be paid to the national conference of commissioners

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8 on uniform state laws, and so much of the balance for each 9 year beginning July I, 1923 and July I, 1924, as may be 10 necessary shall be paid to the commissioners from Maine 11 for the promotion of uniformity of legislation in the United 12 States for their expenses in attending the national con-13 ference of commissioners on uniform state laws, for draft-14 ing and printing reports, postage, and for their other ex-15 penses in performing the duties of said office. All as 16 recommended in report of the committee on budget.
