STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

RESOLVE, Authorizing and Directing the Governor and Council to Convey Certain Land in Monmouth to the Town of Monmouth.

Resolved: That the governor and council are hereby
2 authorized and directed to convey to the town of Monmouth
3 the land constituting the highway leading from the road
4 between Monmouth Center to East Monmouth across land
5 belonging to the state of Maine, near the fish hatchery, to
6 the road leading from Monmouth Center to Tacoma Inn,
7 without any payment therefor.

Sect. 2. Provided, however, that in case this road is at

2 any time discontinued for any reason, the land shall revert
3 to the state.
