IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Prevent Smoking in Street Railroad Cars.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Whoever enters any street railroad car with a lighted pipe,
2 cigar or cigarette, or lights or smokes a pipe, cigar or
3 cigarette therein, except in cars or apartments in cars pro4 vided for that purpose, shall be punished by a fine not ex5 ceeding five dollars, provided a copy of this act, in plain,
6 legible characters, is kept posted in a conspicuous place in
7 such car.
