STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide for the Appointment of a Chief Clerk to the Governor and Council, and Repealing Section Four of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The governor and council shall appoint a chief clerk for 2 the executive department and may define his duties and fix 3 his compensation. Section four, of chapter one hundred 4 and seventeen of the revised statutes, is hereby repealed.
