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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

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RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Purpose of Obtaining Information in Regard to Wild Lands for the Purposes of Taxation.

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Resolved: That the sum of twenty thousand dollars be  
2 appropriated, to be expended by the board of state assessors  
3 under direction of the governor and council, between July  
4 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, and June thirtieth,  
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and a further sum of  
6 twenty thousand dollars, to be expended between July first,  
7 nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and June thirtieth, nine-  
8 teen hundred and twenty-five, for the purpose of employ-

9 ing a competent person or persons whose duty it shall be  
10 to assist said board in verifying and protecting, so far as  
11 practicable, a proper description of each parcel or tract of  
12 wild land, and the individual or corporate ownership there-  
13 of, in townships not incorporated, in order that such lands  
14 may be properly described for taxation purposes, and for  
15 incorporating such description in deeds when the lands are  
16 sold for taxes; also for the employment of a competent  
17 person or persons to assist said board of state assessors in  
18 making such special exploration of wild land townships, and  
19 such lands located in incorporated towns and plantations,  
20 as the board of state assessors may deem advisable, to as-  
21 certain for taxation purposes their just and fair value. Said  
22 board in its regular report shall incorporate a report of the  
23 work done under this resolve and a summarized statement  
24 of its expenditures.
