IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Thirty-eight, of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen, Relative to Retiring and Pensioning Employees of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter thirty-eight, of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, is hereby amended by adding to said act the following section:

'Sect. 3. *The word "employee" defined.* The word employee shall be held to include clerks and employees of the several state departments and institutions and teachers in the state normal schools, who have retired since March first, nineteen hundred and twenty.'
