STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Ninety-three of Chapter Forty-five of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred and Ninety-three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to Settlement of Violations of Law, and Repealing Section Eighty-seven of Chapter Two Hundred and Nineteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to Same Subject.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. Section ninety-three of chapter forty-five of

- 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
- 3 words, "and all offenses under, or violations of, the provi-
- 4 sions of this statute, may be settled by the director of sea

5 and shore fisheries, upon such terms and conditions as he 6 deems advisable," so that said section, as amended, shall 7 read as follows:

'Sect. 93. All fines and penalties under this chapter may 2 be recovered by complaint, indictment or action of debt 3 made or brought in the county where the offense was com-4 mitted. The action of debt shall be brought in the name 5 of the director of sea and shore fisheries. All fines, penal-6 ties and collections under this chapter, except when other-7 wise expressly provided, shall forthwith be paid to the di-8 rector of sea and shore fisheries and by him be paid to the 9 treasurer of state to be added to and made a part of the 10 appropriation for sea and shore fisheries. And the director 11 shall report to the treasurer of state the amount of each 12 fine, penalty and collection itemized and the name of the 13 party paying the same, which shall be kept on record in the 14 treasurer's office.'

Sect. 2. Section eighty-seven of chapter two hundred 2 nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen 3 is hereby repealed.
