STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Repeal the Act Incorporating the Town of Forest City.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The act entitled "An Act to Incorporate the
2 Town of Forest City," approved February fifteenth, eighteen
3 hundred eighty-seven, is hereby repealed; provided, how4 ever, that the corporate existence, powers, duties and lia5 bilities of said town shall survive for the purpose of prose6 cuting and defending all pending suits and causes of suits
7 to which said town is or may be a party, and all needful
8 processes growing out of the same, and for the further pur-

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9 pose of providing for the payment of all or any judgments, 10 which may be rendered against such town.

Sect. 2. All funds unexpended for school purposes at 2 the time when this act is effective out of amounts raised 3 by said town for school purposes or out of amounts paid 4 by the state for school purposes, shall be paid by the treas-5 urer of said town or such other person in whose custody 6 such funds may be, to the treasurer of state. Such amounts, 7 so received, shall constitute a fund for school purposes of 8 which the income only shall be expended and applied for 9 the schooling of children resident within the limits of the 10 present town.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 2 and after the first day of March in the year of our Lord 3 nineteen hundred twenty-four.
